Motion was made by Mr. Stiers, which carried 5:0, to adopt the following ordinance:

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING
CHAPTER 62, ARTICLE II AGRICULTURAL AND
FORESTAL DISTRICTS, SECTION 62-33**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that the need for an emergency ordinance is necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of New Kent County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Virginia Code Section §15.2-1427, the New Kent County Board of Supervisors has the authority to amend adopt an emergency ordinance without prior notice so long as it is enforced for less than 60 days; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the interest of the County and its citizens to amend the Agricultural and Forestal District due date; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that an emergency ordinance is necessary for the citizens as they cannot meet the deadline of March 1 as listed in the statute;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, on this 19th day of February, 2014, Chapter 62, Article II Agricultural and Forestal Districts Section 62-33 is amended, as set forth below for a period not to exceed 60 days:

Sec. 62-33. Application form; fees; due dates.


Any property owner seeking to establish an agricultural and forestal district or add property to an existing district shall make an application to the board of supervisors upon

the application forms provided in the office of the county administrator. Such application shall be accompanied by payment of a fee in the amount as provided in Appendix A to this Code to cover the costs of processing and reviewing the application, including costs of advertising the required public hearings. Applications for the creation of, or addition to, a district shall be received by the department of community development on or before ~~March~~ April 1. Applications for withdrawal from, or termination of, a district shall be received by the department of community development on or before ~~March~~ April 1.

This Ordinance takes effect upon adoption.
