

The County of New Kent Electoral Board met on Tuesday, November 3, 2016 in the Health and Human Service Building, large conference Room (before the Chief's and Assistant Chief's training session), in New Kent. Chairman Moss called the meeting to order at 5:38 p.m. with all members present, including, Karen Bartlett, General Registrar; P. Simone Thornton, Chief Assistant Registrar; and Frances Gardner, Assistant Registrar.

DISCUSSIONS: USAGE OF PAPER POLL BOOKS / ELECTRONIC POLL BOOKS OTHER CLARIFACATIONS, SELFIES, SAFETY, FRAUD, ETC: Mr. Moore brought up the fact that selfies have been in the newspaper and according to the General Assembly, Va. Law code §24.2-640, we do allow selfies in the polling place in Virginia and that everyone working need to know. The person taking the selfie however, cannot include another person in the selfie, without consent of the other person that may be in the picture. Cannot take a picture of a voted ballot. The media cannot take a picture of a person voting without their permission. If that happens it could land that person taking the picture, via cell phone up to 24 hours in jail.

Mr. Moss and Ms. Bartlett will explain the paper poll book and the electronic poll books; how they will be used side by side for checking in voters to the chief's and assistant chiefs coming in the next training session. Mr. Moore and Mr. Winson will talk about the selfies and the flow of the lines in the precinct with splits. He also motioned that the paper poll books should all be a complete paper poll book to eliminate lines if there is a backup or choking point in the lines then any and everything should be noted on the incident report for the board to examine during the canvass meeting the next day after the election. Mr. Winson made the motion and Mr. Moore seconded. The Board member were polled.
