**AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO § 58.1-3813.1
OF THE CODE OF VIRGINIA TO AMEND
§ 66-272(a) OF THE CODE OF NEW KENT COUNTY TO INCREASE THE
ENHANCED 911 TAX FROM \$2.42 TO \$3.00 PER MONTH**


WHEREAS, §66-272 of the Code of New Kent County imposes a tax in the amount of \$2.42 per telephone bill; and

WHEREAS, §58.1-3813.1 of the Code of Virginia permits the Board of Supervisors to impose such tax up to an amount of \$3.00 per month; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that such additional revenue is necessary to maintain and improve the E-911 system throughout the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED under the authority granted pursuant to §58.1-3813.1 of the Code of Virginia that §66-272(a) of the Code of New Kent County be amended to increase the amount of the tax for enhanced 911 service from \$2.42 to \$3.00 per month.

This Ordinance shall become effective 120 days after its adoption by the Board of Supervisors.
