

The County of New Kent Electoral Board met on Wednesday, March 4, 2020 in the Health and Human Service Building large conference Room in New Kent to conduct the March 3, 2020 Democratic Party Presidential Primary Canvass meeting. Chairman Moss called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. with all team members Simone Thornton, Chief Assistant and Mr. Jeffries were present. Mr. Winson was out of town this week, expected back on Thursday evening. Mr. Moss thanked everyone for the hard work on yesterday and thanked them for being prompt for the canvass meeting today. The canvass teams were placed with all Chiefs and the Electoral Board member and or 4<sup>th</sup> panel member per table.

CANVASS MEETING: Chairman Moss started with the instructions for the canvass. The Secretary of the Board, Larry Reynolds resigned from the Board on February 14, 2020 by letter, so the Judge appointed Mr. William Jeffries former Board member as a Temporary, Acting member of the Board. Mr. Jeffries was assigned duty as Temporary Acting Chairman. Mr. Moss was Acting Secretary on this day of the canvass. The four panels were given the precincts that were assigned for them to check.

Each precinct was checked thoroughly for omissions as well as the Election Officers' oaths and results tapes. All forms that were put in Envelope number two were double checked and placed back in envelope 2, then resealed by the Electoral Board.

The Board continued after the panels were dismissed with the certifications and provisional ballot meeting in the Registrar's office.

CONSIDERATION OF PROVISIONAL BALLOTS: It was determined that there were three provisional ballots out of which all three were not registered on Election Day in New Kent County, However, one had Identification with her New Kent County Address. That one was excepted by the Board members. The other two were not. The canvass will recess until the abstracts are completed on Friday, March 6, 2020.
