

The County of New Kent Electoral Board met on Wednesday, June 24, 2020 in the Health and Human Service Building large conference Room in New Kent to conduct the June 23, 2020 Democratic Party and Republican Party Primary Canvass meeting. Due to the Coronavirus and following guidelines from the County and Governor of the State of Virginia, Chairman Moss called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. with only two precincts at a time and an Electoral Board member on a team. A two-member team to check the results of that district. Mini-meetings to hopefully conclude in 30-minute intervals being carefully monitored and observed by Chairman Moss and the Registrar for guidance. Secretary Winson and Acting Vice Chairman Jeffries assisted the Precinct Chief or Assistant Chief. As usual the teams checked each other's precinct for discrepancies on paperwork, completion or errors. Being a first time doing the canvas this way, we tried to be consistent and careful not to have more than six people in the large conference room at a time. All the bags envelopes and supplies were locked and left in the large conference room overnight and disinfected and sanitized. Mask were worn and seated 6 feet apart.

Mr. Moss thanked everyone for the hard work on yesterday and thanked them for being prompt to come at their designated time for that district's canvass meeting today.

CANVASS MEETING: The Registrar started with the instructions for the canvass. After the teams disbursed the three-member Board and the Registrar begin the final steps, in checking the results to certify the results and begin process on Provision ballots and complete the abstracts.

CONSIDERATION OF PROVISIONAL BALLOTS Five out of six Provisional ballots were received and added to the count. The sixth one was an I.D. issue that need to be presented by the Electoral Board by 12 noon on Friday, June 26, 2020 If voter failed to produce their I.D. then the ballot would not be added to the count and returned to the courthouse .Each precinct was checked thoroughly for omissions as well as the Election Officers' oaths and results tapes. All forms that were put in Envelope number two were double checked and placed back in envelope two, then resealed by the Electoral Board. The other five provisional ballots were people who had requested an absentee ballot to be mailed to them and brought there ballot back to the precinct to vote. Once it was determined that their ballot had been properly returned their ballot was counted. The canvass will recess until the abstracts are completed on Friday, June 26, 2020.
