Motion was made by Mrs. Ringley, which carried 5:0, to adopt the following Ordinance:

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR  
REDUCED MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAX  
FOR AUXILIARY DEPUTY SHERIFFS**

UPON PUBLIC HEARING DULY HAD, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED THAT:

Pursuant to §46.2-752 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, Section 10-49 (b) of the New Kent County Code is hereby AMENDED to provide that auxiliary New Kent County Deputy Sheriffs shall receive a reduction of one half (1/2) of the applicable County vehicle license tax as follows (changes are in italic):

- (b) The license tax on such passenger vehicle, pick-up or panel truck registered *(i)* to a member of the Virginia National Guard and bearing Virginia National Guard license plates or, *(ii)* to a member of a volunteer Fire Department or Rescue Squad, or, *(iii)* to an auxiliary New Kent County Sheriff Deputy, shall be one-half of the fee applicable to the type of vehicle license. The chief administrative officer of the Volunteer Fire Department or Volunteer Rescue Squad, or the Sheriff of New Kent County in the case of auxiliary Deputy Sheriffs, shall send to the Treasurer a verified list of active members or auxiliary Deputy Sheriffs, one month before vehicle licenses go on sale in order for a member or auxiliary Deputy Sheriff to qualify. Each active member or auxiliary Deputy Sheriff shall be entitled to the reduced fee for one vehicle only.

All other provisions of Section 10-49 of the New Kent County Code shall remain in effect.

This Ordinance Amendment shall be effective immediately.
