Motion was made by Mr. Burrell, which carried 4:1 to adopt the following ordinance:

**ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT BOUNDARY LINES
OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND PRECINCTS
FOR NEW KENT COUNTY, VIRGINIA**

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority and procedures contained in Section 15.2-1400, Section 15.2-1211, Section 24.2-223, Section 24.2-304.1, Sections 24.2-305 through 24.2-311 of the *Code of Virginia, 1950 (as amended)*, the election districts and precincts of New Kent County, Virginia, are hereby created and established as set forth below.

Section 2. The election districts shall be as follows:

Election District 1
Election District 2
Election District 3
Election District 4
Election District 5

Section 3. There shall be one supervisor and one school board member elected from each election district, each with a four-year term.

Section 4. The boundaries of each election district may be found in the attached map are described as follows:

ELECTION DISTRICT 1

Election District 1 shall comprise the area bounded as follows:

ELECTION DISTRICT 2

Section 7. All mileage given to describe the boundaries of the Election Districts and Precincts are approximate.

Section 8. The existing Ordinance entitled “An Ordinance to Repeal and Re-enact Sections 2-20 through 2-31 of the New Kent County Code Establishing Electoral Districts and Election Precincts in New Kent” adopted by the Board of Supervisors on the 28th day of May, 1991 is hereby repealed.

Section 9. Any other Ordinances that conflict with this Ordinance shall be repealed to the extend necessary to give full force and effect to this Ordinance, but shall otherwise remain in full force.

Section 10. Should any portion of this Ordinance be found to be in violation of the law and therefore be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 11. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption as provided in §24.2-311 of the Code of Virginia and shall apply to all elections after December 31, 2001 or after the U.S. Department of Justice has notified the County that the Ordinance has received pre-clearance, whichever shall occur later.

Section 12. The County Attorney shall submit this Ordinance and accompanying materials to support this Ordinance to the proper authorities for pre-clearance and notification purposes.
