

TO RESTORE DRIVING PRIVILEGE

If you have been declared a habitual offender or have been convicted of DUI third offense and you want to petition the court to have your driving privileges reinstated, first **contact DMV and request a compliance letter**. This is a very important step because DMV will be able to tell you all requirements necessary to reinstate your license. You may need to petition the court as a habitual offender, for DUI third, or both.

Filing fees for either type of petition are \$84. There is an additional amount of \$24 due for service fees. The total due is \$108 per petition.

You may petition the court where you were last convicted, declared a habitual offender, or currently live.
