

## OFFICIAL VOTING INFORMATION - NEW KENT COUNTY

The Constitution of Virginia requires that you be registered in the precinct in which you live in order to be qualified to vote.

The New Kent Co. Voter Registration Office, located at 12003 New Kent Hwy., New Kent, is open each week, Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

In order to be eligible to vote in the General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2009, you must register no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 5, 2009.

The Voter Registration Office of New Kent Co. will be open on Monday, October 5, 2009 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for the purpose of registering qualified persons and receiving name and address changes.

The office will also be open on Saturday, October 24, 2009 and Saturday, October 31, 2009 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for the purpose of accepting applications for absentee ballot for this election. October 31, 2009 is the last day that application for absentee ballot may be made in person by qualified applicants for this election.

In order to make absentee voting as accessible as possible, disabled voters are able to vote absentee using an ADA compliant voting unit in the Office of the General Registrar in New Kent during the 45 day absentee voting period. Curbside absentee voting is also available for qualified applicants.

All requests for reasonable accommodations due to a disability should be made to the Registrar with at least a 48-hour notice.
