Board Meeting Recap

At its meeting on August 9, the Board of Supervisors:

- Adopted resolutions in tribute to the late Thelma Crump Wilson, and in recognition of resident Jill Cruz, recently installed as President of LaSertoma International.
- Approved the proposed 2012 Budget Calendar
- Adopted resolutions updating the County's policy regarding the timing of acceptance of cash proffers as well as its PPEA guidelines, in order to comply with changes in the State Code.
- Approved the proposed Community Services Board performance contract.
- Adopted a resolution requesting that New Kent be declared a crop drought disaster area
- Approved the County Attorney's contract
- Received a presentation on the 2010 *Taking Root* Farm Tour
- Accepted the unsolicited PPEA proposal from Marengo Management Corp to renovate the historic school, triggering a 45-day period to accept competing proposals
- Approved rezoning applications for Whitmore Chevrolet
- Denied a CUP application to construct a cell tower on property located on Topeka Road
- Approved all applications to add property to the AFD Program as well as the realignment of the agricultural and forestal districts.
