

The County of New Kent Electoral Board met on Wednesday, November 8, 2017 in the Health and Human Service Building large conference Room in New Kent to conduct the November 7, 2017 General Elections Canvass meeting. Chairman Moss called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. with all Board members and team members present. Mr. Moss thanked everyone for the hard work on yesterday and thanked them for being prompt for the canvass meeting today. The canvass teams were placed with all Chiefs and the Electoral Board members per table, in 4 groups. No observers were present in this meeting The Registrar had only heard from Ms. Susan Moon, the new chairman of the New Kent Democratic Party to say that she would not have anyone able to observe this time

CANVASS MEETING: Chairman Moss started with the instructions for this year’s canvass. Secretary Jeffries had just been appointed back with the Board, so he observed. The four panels were given the precincts that were assigned for them to check.

Each precinct was checked by each panel and the “New” Statement of Results were checked thoroughly for omissions as well as the Election Officers’ oaths and results tapes. All forms that were put in Envelope number two were double checked and placed back in envelope 2, then resealed by the Electoral Board.

The Board continued after the panels were dismissed with the certifications and provisional ballot meeting.

CONSIDERATION OF PROVISIONAL BALLOTS: It was determined that there were eleven provisional ballots out of which two were provision Identification required, that were cast in the election on yesterday. All eleven were counted in this year’s election. Eleven Provisionals were counted and added to the certification tally. The two provisional ID voters has until 12:00 noon on Monday, November 13, 2017 to present proper identification. The canvass will recess until that time. Abstracts will be worked on and signed once the canvass is completed on Monday, due to the Veteran’s Day holiday on Friday, Nov. 10, 2017.
