

# What is Single-Stream Recycling?

Single-Stream Recycling is the process in which all acceptable materials are collected all mixed together with no sorting required.

## Acceptable Materials Include:

Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs, etc.

Cardboard (please break down boxes)

Paperboard (cereal, tissue, shoe boxes, etc.)

Junk Mail & Envelopes (all types)

Telephone & Soft Cover Books

Paper (all colors-no rubber bands, paper clips or plastic wrap.)

Plastic Bottles, Jugs & Containers (marked #1-#7)

Soda, Juice & Water Bottles (glass or plastic)

Glass Bottles & Jars (any color)

Aluminum (pie plates, trays, foil, etc.)



A decal (pictured at left) can be issued at the refuse site for the purpose of depositing refuse and recycling, only after residents have provided proof of residency by showing their valid driver's license and valid vehicle registration.

This decal must be placed on the vehicle either by the resident or by the attendant while still at the site. It can be placed at either of the following locations: 1) exterior windshield to the right of the inspection sticker (placed by refuse attendant) or 2) back of the rearview mirror (placed by resident only). Those who prefer not to place a decal on their vehicle may show their driver's license each time they visit a New Kent County refuse center.



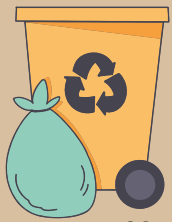

Mission: To provide safe and clean facilities for residents of New Kent County to deposit limited quantities of solid waste and designated recycled goods.

Facility Use: These facilities are open to New Kent County **RESIDENTS ONLY**. Proof of residency will be required. All residents attempting to use the centers must present to the attendant a valid driver's license or have a refuse and recycling decal affixed to their vehicle. Those failing to produce a valid driver's license or proof of county residency will not be permitted to use the facilities.

### Preparation of Refuse:

- No resident shall transport any refuse in an open or uncovered vehicle along the streets, roads, or highways of the county, unless the load is covered by a suitable cover to prevent escaping.
- Refuse shall be drained free of liquids before being placed in collection containers.



## Acceptable items - all refuse sites:

- Household trash
- Single-Stream Recyclables (refer to the list in this brochure)
- Organic materials - leaves (bagged)
- Recyclable oil (used motor oil - containers must be clearly labeled)

## Acceptable items - Route 618 (main site) only:

- Organic materials - limbs (6 inches in diameter & no more than 6 feet long)
- Appliances (emptied)
- Recyclable oil (used cooking oil - containers must be clearly labeled)
- Lawn Mowers (gas & oil must be drained out & tires removed)
- Electronics
- Scrap Metal
- Batteries
- Household Semi Hazardous Waste - (Including: paints, stains, bug and weed killers, antifreeze, etc. - containers must be clearly labeled)

## Items NOT accepted:

- Materials that have NOT been prepared for collection in accordance with this brochure.
- Construction Debris (shingles, siding, cement, concrete, blocks, bricks, lumber, etc.)
- Dead Animals
- Large automotive parts
- Tires
- Ashes/Coals
- Asbestos
- Medical Waste
- Gasoline
